Living God, creator, redeemer, strengthener: enliven, guide and strengthen your Church in all you send us to do. By your Holy Spirit enable us to grow - in faith, in service, in generous giving; and add to your Church new disciples that your saving, reconciling, recreating work may go forward, through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

Rev'd Derek Barrett's Commentary on the Readings:

Psalm 104

All the metaphors that concern the Holy Spirit involve movement, like stir, move, breathe, descend, flow. Nothing is static or stale. Today's psalm sets the pattern, sea, ships, playing in the deep, gathering food, sending forth the spirit, the earth trembles, smoking mountains, even singing songs requires lips and lungs to move. The writer of this psalm is taking us back to the creation stories in Genesis with the Spirit of God brooding on the waters and he invites us to see and enjoy the procession of God-given items and actions. Try to see through the poet's eyes heaven and earth, winds and flames, seas and rivers, birds and beasts, oil and wine. The Creator sees that it is all very satisfactory and the writer revels in the Maker's joy. This is what Holy Spirit does. The Third Person of the One Undivided Holy Trinity is the Connector and the Connection. Our Parish Priest has asked us to wear something red today on the Feast of Pentecost.

Philippians 4

So ends the imprisoned Apostle's letter with Timothy by his side describing both of them as simply servants (slaves) of Christ writing a very personal message to all who had become Christians and therefore also servants of Christ. Together they not only served and labored for Him, set apart from others, but were actually owned by Him and belonged to Him, body, soul and spirit devotedly and

inseparably. This is a central thought today as we celebrate the life and devotion of St. Francis of Assisi. This ninety or so minutes in Church together week by week is vital in keeping us on track as we resolve not selfishly for ourselves, but selflessly responding to and for the sake of everyone else regardless of inconvenience and risk.

Matthew 6

"No-one can serve two masters" seems very obvious but it becomes complicated when the question of laying up treasure on earth is considered. We say that we accept that everything we need is going to be provided, but how many of us could or would go so far as Saint Francis who divested even his clothing in determining to have nothing to fall back on? If we are not prepared for every eventuality to be provided for, we cannot possibly be thought of as those who are doing the right thing, freed up to seek The Kingdom and its righteousness.
