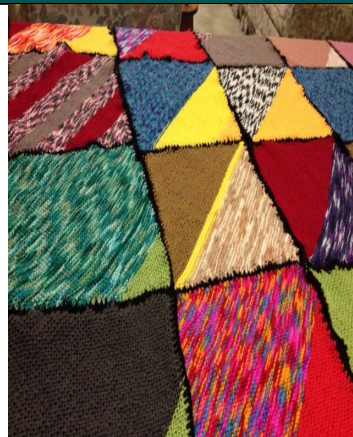

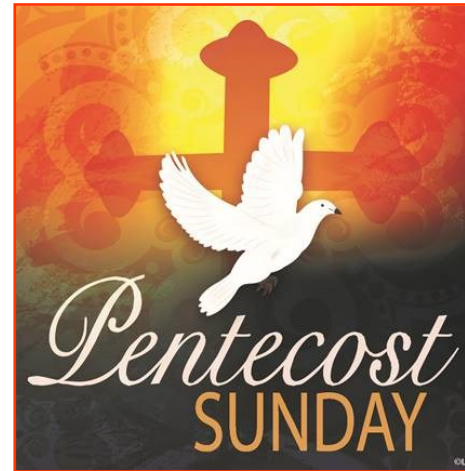

**READINGS FOR THE DAY**

**A READING FROM THE ACTS OF THE APOSTLES**  
**CHAPTER 2: BEGINNING AT THE 1ST VERSE: (Pew Bible page 885)**

When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place. And suddenly from heaven there came a sound like the rush of a violent wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting. Divided tongues, as of fire, appeared among them, and a tongue rested on each of them. All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other languages, as the Spirit gave them ability. Now there were devout Jews from every nation under heaven living in Jerusalem. And at this sound the crowd gathered and was bewildered, because each one heard them speaking in their native language of each. Amazed and astonished, they asked, "Are not all these who are speaking Galileans? And how is it that we hear, each of us, in our own native language? Parthians, Medes, Elamites, and residents of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya belonging to Cyrene, and visitors from Rome, both Jews and proselytes, Cretans and Arabs - in our own languages we hear them speaking about God's deeds of power." All were amazed and perplexed, saying to one another, "What does this mean?" But others sneered and said, "They are filled with new wine." But Peter, standing with the eleven, raised his voice and addressed them, "Men of Judea and all who live in Jerusalem, let this be known to you, and listen to what I say. Indeed, these are not drunk, as you suppose, for it is only nine o'clock in the morning. No, this is what was spoken through the prophet Joel: 'In the last days it will be, God declares, that I will pour out my Spirit upon all flesh, and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams. Even upon my slaves, both men and women, in those days I will pour out my Spirit; and they shall prophesy. And I will show portents in the heaven above and signs on the earth below, blood, and fire, and smoky mist. The sun shall be turned to darkness and the moon to blood, before the coming of the Lord's great and glorious day. Then everyone who calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved.'"

**Rev'd Derek Barrett's Commentary on the Readings:**

**Psalm 104** - On the Feast of Pentecost our worship is centred on the theme of spirit and spirituality. It is because of verse 32 that this psalm has been chosen for the only Old Testament reading today. The psalm-writer has been meditating on the creation story and has been marveling at the thought of clouds, winds, seas, hills, fire, earth, springs, cattle, mankind, and has come to the conclusion that all these elements came into being because of what the Hebrew people called Ruarch, that which lies behind the hymn, "Breathe on me, Breath of God." Verse 32 reads, "When you send forth Your Spirit all are created and You renew the face of the earth." So fifty days after Passover our Jewish ancestors celebrated Pentecost which has Harvest Festival connotations. "All good things around us are sent from God above." This is why on this day we praise the Lord for all his gifts of love. The Lord is here, we say. His Spirit is with us.

**Romans 8** - The great apostle tells his readers and hearers what has happened to them as a result of their baptism. They have been made new, they have inherited the gift of sonship because this is what the Spirit does. We pray: "Fill me with life anew." It is in this power of the Holy Spirit that we come to the Father as His children. Jesus kept nothing back. We share our inheritance with Him. This is our corporate birthday. The Church was born on this day and we are all members of it and we all have equal shares in it. On this Feast of Pentecost we rejoice because we are sharing everything Jesus has secured for us. We are not promised that everything will be easy and trouble-free. Our Lord suffered without complaint and through the power of the Spirit we are given the strength to bear each others burdens as well as our own with His own calm and dignity.

**John 14** - These words were penned half a century or so after the death of Jesus and they reflect the belief and behaviour of a community of like-minded people who really believed that what He had promised had been delivered. They did not have the historical Lord of life with them, indeed most of them had never met Him in the flesh, but they knew they were living in His Presence. He had sent the Advocate, the Paraclete, the Counsellor who had made it possible to make the break from Judaism and to exist despite the power of the mighty Roman Empire. They opened doors to people, making them feel "at home" and they inspired strangers to remark, "See how these Christians love one another!" Not only an example but an inspiration.
